



Israel: One Land, Three Journeys!

There are many reasons to want to travel to Israel... and we've got 3 of them covered!

In the summer of 2012, CJC, CJCS and OMI (the Meeting House) are cooperatively offering 3 simultaneous trips to Israel:

- *Family Trip (CJC), led by Rabbi Sonya Starr
- *Teen Trip (CJCS), led by Jerry Kiewe
- *Inter-faith Trip (OMI) co-led by Rabbi Ilyse Kramer & Deacon Peter Barbernitz, Adult Educator, SJERC

Air travel has not yet been determined but we anticipate group departure on Sunday, July 1 and return on Sunday, July 15, 2012.

Itineraries will vary; each trip is uniquely designed to provide an optimal experience for both first-time and returning travelers to Israel, but ALL trips will...

- enable participants to experience the diversity of Israel – to meet various ethnic groups, learn about different religious and political perspectives, etc.
- spend significant time in Jerusalem while also exploring other ancient sites and modern cities throughout Israel
- enable participants to deepen their understanding of Israel – the land, history, culture and present-day realities
- foster close ties among the participants as they share travel experiences, trade impressions, and “breathe in” Israel’s spiritual atmosphere



Standard per person pricing for all trips is listed below:

Family Trip = \$3,113 plus airfare (based on 25 participants)

Teen Trip = \$3,181 plus airfare (based on 15 participants)

Inter-faith Trip = \$3,035 plus airfare (based on 20 participants)

** Pricing does not include airfare, airfare-related taxes or fees, ground transportation to/from local airport, optional medical or travel insurance, laundry service, or personal expenses.

** Pricing does include all taxes, tips and gratuities while in Israel and most meals.

** Pricing presumes specific occupancy. Additions/reductions are available for alternative occupancy arrangements.

Besides variations for each trip, there are also price variations based upon membership status at CJC and/or student status at CJCS.
