Taharah, carried out by community members joining together to form a Chevra Kadisha (Holy Society), is the mitzvah of caring for those who have died. It is the subject of a three-part information and training session sponsored by the Howard County Board of Rabbis and the Howard County Jewish Federation.

## **Learn about**

- the history and evolution of Jewish care for the deceased, what motivates people to do this mitzvah, and the emotional, spiritual and community building aspects of the work
- the Tahara liturgy, a series of prayers composed in 1626, use by virtually all Chevrot Kadisha around the world
- hands on taharah training including washing, dressing and safety issues.
